In order to best ensure safety, we have asked students to wear masks while they are playing in the gaga ball pit during recess. Gaga ball is very physical, and while playing, students are close together, and tend to yell and scream. We want to keep this game open to our students since it's a favorite activity for many, and provides an excellent chance for large body movement.

Our art teacher, Karie Neal, recently brought International Peace Day to SRS, and our students and staff have been busy making pinwheels to celebrate together. We welcome all of our Preschool students and their families to Swift River!

We have two programs, as you know, for preschool: full-day (at a rate of \$25/day), and half-day (at a rate of \$15/day).

Families will be billed on a payment plan of \$400/mo for full-day, and \$240/mo for half-day. Here is how we got that number:

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Full-Day

 $25/day \times 4 days = 100/wk$

 $100/wk \times 40 \text{ weeks} = 4,000/yr$

$$2,400/yr \div 10 \text{ months} = 240/mo$$

 $4,000/yr \div 10 \text{ months} = 400/mo$

This billing cycle will ensure that monthly cost will not fluctuate with the calendar.

Some Parents May Be Eligible for Reduced Broadband Bills!

Two days ago the FCC announced that again this school year, households that can demonstrate participation in the free and reduced price school lunch program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision, are also eligible for the Emergency Broadband Benefit that reduces monthly bills for broadband service accounts. Households without school-aged children may also apply for the EBB monthly discount.
